The first line is tacking angles. We use them to calibrate our Tactic compass. Second line is wind speed in knots.

Rake 8 for example: means 25'-8" measured from main halyard hoisted to bottom of transom with mast straight and about 5 pounds of rig tension.

Ram scale is .25" increment marks on mast. 0 is on top and 7 on bottom. To calibrate, set rake at 25'-8", use 10-20 pounds of rig tension (just snug), adjust ram so mast is straight, then make 1/4" marks on mast with ram at #7, as set up.

CB is centerboard with inches raised above center board trunk/cap.
